### Notes

- All lodges: No smoking. No pets
- All 1st priority bookings made in the 1 priority period have equal priority. Then all bookings are taken in order of receipt.
- Midweek, for booking priority purposes, is five nights, Sunday to Thursday, at Anton, Dinner Plain and Falls Creek. Perisher 4 night (Sunday to Wednesday) and 3 night (Thursday to Saturday) are equivalent. Individual lodges may accept different booking start days/durations after the initial booking priority period. Dinner Plain also allows other complying bookings in the booking priority period, see lodge details for further information.
- Weekend minimum booking: Friday and Saturday nights (no single nights)
- Refer to lodge details or booking officer for opening of bookings for summer and winter stays other than 7 or 5 nights beginning Sunday
- Refer to lodge details for variations: ie children's rates etc
- Rates from Friday of Queen's Birthday Weekend (NSW & Vic) except where noted for individual lodges
- Restrictions on age of children for family booking priority may vary at individual lodges
- All prices include GST (except Niseko).

## [Making a booking 2022](#)

Some lodges may have overriding conditions and rates if COVID-19 precautions are in place. COVID-19 precautions may include requirement for proof of vaccination status at time of booking, or prior to stay or on arrival.

### Online Bookings

- Members of Anton, Dinner Plain, Falls Creek and Perisher are encouraged to use the online booking system that is accessible from their websites.

- The online booking system allows AAC members to book into most other AAC lodges as well as their own. (Most of the AAC lodges have enabled this feature.) To book into an AAC lodge other than your own, log on to the desired lodge using your member number, surname and the name of your own lodge from the 'Login From' list.
- If including other members in your booking at a lodge other than their home lodge, get them to quickly log in to that lodge first. This is necessary to ensure that they can be offered the correct rate.

For bookings to be confirmed

- Current annual subscription must have been paid.
- Payment in full must be made.

### Priorities

- Different priority bookings are processed on the different dates. When lodging bookings that have different priorities, it is essential to make separate bookings and separate payments for the different priorities, otherwise your bookings will be processed at the date of the lowest priority you lodge.

### Family and guests

- Non-member spouse and children of a member must be accompanied by the member. Different conditions apply to Niseko.
- The lodges are run for their members. Guests must be booked, and paid for, by their accompanying member.

### Information to be supplied when making a booking

- Booking is via the CBDWeb on-line system. The Booking member should check their contact details are correct whilst booking. Names must be provided for guests at time of booking.

### What to take

- Most lodges provide linen in winter but require you to supply your own in summer. See individual lodge details

### Changing bookings

- Bookings are made available only to the people specifically named in the booking. Bookings are not transferable. If someone booked can't attend, a new booking must be made through the booking agent, who will give preference to those on the waiting list. Please don't arrive at the lodge with a 'transferred' booking - it won't be accepted.

### Cancelling bookings

- Please notify cancellations promptly.
- Cancellations will create a credit in the booking system.
- Applications for refunds must be made in writing to the relevant lodge's Booking Officer, by the end of the season.

## Anton Huette (Hotham) Booking Information 2022

These rules will apply at Anton to the extent of any difference with other quoted AAC policies.

### Booking Payment

Online bookings are credit or debit card only. No bookings will be held without payment. If you cannot pay by credit or debit card, EFT can only be arranged via the Booking Agent.

### Cancellation Policy.

- 28 or more days notice = 75% refund
- 27 or less days notice = no refund
- You can book with confidence. Cancellations activated by the club in response to official government restrictions for Covid 19 will be credited in full.

### Seasons

Please note Anton is closed for renovations until Easter 2022.

- Winter Peak: 26/6/22 to 3/9/22

- Off Peak: 10/6/22 to 25/6/22 and 4/9/22 to 1/10/22
- Summer: 2/10/22 onwards until start of 2023 season

### Booking priority opening dates

For full week and 5 day midweek bookings:

- Full Members and Junior member: 1 Feb
- Associate Members and AAC Reciprocal bookings: 1 March
- Direct Family Guests (partner and children only): 8 March
- Guests: 15 March

For weekend and short (<4 days) midweek bookings:

- Full Members: 28 days in advance
- Associate Members and AAC Reciprocal bookings: 16 days in advance
- Guests: 15 days in advance

Members (adults & junior) participating in official race training and events

- Can book bunkrooms 15 & 16 for weekends from 1 February 2020. Note minimum booking 2 nights.

### Other Booking Rules

- Minimum stay 2 nights
- Maximum booking 3 weeks
- Free rate anytime for Child Under 4 is dependent on the child sleeping in porta cot or similar in double room where both bed places are booked and paid for by parents/guardians. Child Under 4 free rate does not apply to bunk rooms. All other children pay Child rates.
- Best efforts will be made but no guarantee of male only or female only bunk rooms or twin single rooms. Bunk rooms and king single twin rooms can be booked on a unisex basis at the discretion of the booking agent and reference to the committee to ensure that maximum member usage is made possible.
- **NEW: Check in time: 3:00pm**
- **NEW: Check out time: 11:00am**  
Check out means all room and kitchen storage to be emptied. No further use of the lodge above the downstairs video room (for bag storage only). Bags must be retrieved from the video room no later than 2:45pm.

## Dinner Plain Lodge Booking Information 2022/23

- Members should make and pay for bookings via the booking website. When booking ensure your contact details are up-to-date in each booking. If you have a problem booking or paying, or you wish to change or add to your booking, email all details to the booking officer.
- Winter and Off-peak dinner is **included in tariff** 6 nights/week. Vegetarian and coeliac diets will be catered for and **must** be advised at least two weeks in advance of visit. All other special diets need to self cater.
- Late arrival during winter: If you require dinner to be kept, phone Lodge Manager during week prior.
- Bedroom cleaning \$30 per room, \$5 per bunk bed and linen \$20 per person. Linen exchanged for clean linen during booking, by arrangement with lodge managers, \$20 per person.
- Each room has one car park allocated.
- During summer, visitors are responsible for cleaning the communal areas. Visitors may pay to have the communal area cleaned for them by paying the communal area cleaning fee of \$160 at the time of the booking.
- During summer the spa is only available when requested in advance via booking officer: \$80 for set up and cleaning.
- The bunk room may be booked exclusively by families of 5 with 3 or more children.
- Members booking in guests must be present for the full duration of the booking.
- Members may book a maximum of two rooms and bring a maximum of five adult guests per booking in the winter and off-peak periods.

- Between February 1st and March 15th a member may book a maximum of 14 days during the Winter and Off Peak periods.
- 18 to 26 year old Dinner Plain members will be charged AAC rate for their 18 to 26 y/o guests.
- All adult visitors to the lodge must abide by posted signage and directions from the Lodge Managers.
- Cancellations may be done online or by emailing Booking Officer

## AAC Falls Creek Booking Information 2022

- Covid Safe procedures may overrule published conditions including, but not limited to, obligations of members and guests, services provided, occupancy restrictions, check-in/check-out, and length of bookings.
- Until further notice, full Coronavirus vaccination (or official exemption) is required for all members and guests 16 and over.
- Peaks Challenge bicycle event weekend (11-13 March): min 2 night booking, special rate & services. **BOOKED OUT**, but contact booking officer in case of cancellations.
- Members & guests under 18 years must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
- Children under 18 years old at time of stay are charged at 50% adult rate.
- Children under 3 years old at time of stay are free-of-charge.
- Week is seven nights: Sunday to Saturday nights.
- Mid-Week is five nights: Sunday to Thursday nights.
- Weekend is two nights: Friday & Saturday nights.
- Included in tariffs: Continental breakfast in ski season plus full cooked breakfast Mon-Sat in winter peak season.
- Bed linen and towels are provided and rooms cleaned on departure during ski season only.
- Bookings during peak winter season of more than two continuous weeks and large guest group bookings are subject to Committee approval.
- Spa and sauna are not open in summer except for special events.
- No pets.
- Opening times for weekend and other bookings other than Week, Midweek, Opening or Race weekends

Single nights can only be booked 1 day prior

Members: 19 days prior (Monday)

AAC reciprocal: 16 days prior (Thursday)

Guests: 15 days prior (Friday)
