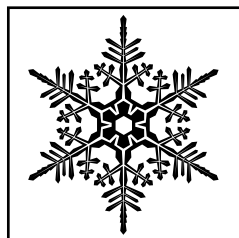
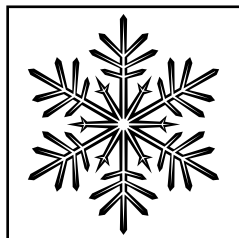

- Minimum Summer booking \$220.
- Continental breakfast ingredients including milk provided in winter.
- Off-peak tariff is from 5 to 27 June and from 6 September until lifts close.
- Members children under 5 free of charge when staying in parent's room.
- No guest children under 5 at any time except Children's Week, School holidays and during summer.
- Children's week is 13 to 19 September.
- Members and guests under 18 years must be accompanied by an adult.
- Club race week 2 August to 8 August. Surcharge of \$70 per person. Non refundable.
- Room 14 (Bunk Room) is for members only and weekends only.
- Room 5 and Room 7 bookable in advance by members only, for weekends, excluding school holidays, until guest bookings open.
- We expect the oversnow transport for luggage to operate as usual contact 0408 516 162.

- Off peak from season open to week commencing 28 June 2009 and from week commencing 30 August to end of season.
- AAC Falls Creek Race Weekend : 7-8 August Members \$118; AAC \$135; Guest \$220, includes presentation dinner and race entry.(children half price).
- Kangaroo Hoppet 29 August - check falls creek website for details.
- Childrens' week not offered in 2009.
- Children Under 17 years old at time of stay are charged at 50% of adult rate. Children under 3 are free of charge at all times.
- Mid-Week is five nights, Sunday to Thursday (still only charged for 4 nights).
- Season opening weekend special offer at summer rates. Summer rates apply at all other non season times.
- Included in tariffs: Full Breakfast in winter peak season and continental in off peak season. Bed linen is provided in the winter season and rooms cleaned on departure.
- Booking during the winter peak season of more than 2 continuous weeks and large guest bookings are subject to Committee approval.
- Summer: minimum booking of \$220 for lodge opening, groups of 8 or more adults in summer at AAC rates, groups of 15 or more adults in summer at member rates. Members and guests must bring their own bed linen.
- No Pets.

- Guests children must be of school age. No guest babies or toddlers are allowed to stay in the Ski Lodge.
- Guests under 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Sheets, pillow slips and towels provided.
- Guests must understand that the Club requires both members and guests to complete various housekeeping duties whilst they are at the Ski Lodge. Clearing your table after eating, washing your dishes and keeping the kitchen tidy is everyone's responsibility. Before you leave, clean and tidy your bedroom and remove all unused food and drinks from the kitchen, your food drawer, refrigerator and the bar.
- Guest and AAC use limited in: Second week of July school holidays, Club and AAC Race weekends, and Victorian Interschools week. Discounted weekly rate not applicable at these times.

- Linen should be taken but can be hired from managers in winter (notify when booking/pay lodge manager).
- Continental winter breakfast: \$30.00/week or \$6.00/day (notify when booking/pay lodge manager).
- Winter dinner: **Included in tariff** on 6 nights (excluding Wednesday) from Friday 5 June until lifts close.
- Late arrival dinner: Phone lodge manager during week prior.
- Club race week: with Anton Huette 2-8 August.
- Bookings of 10 adults or more in summer: Guests at AAC rates.
- Weekend minimum stay: Friday and Saturday nights.

- Children under 6 are not permitted between 26 July to 22 August.
- Children's weeks: 6-12 September (low season); 13-19 September (adults at low season + children under 18 @ ½ low season adult tariff).
- Babies under 2 are free during mid, low and Summer tariff periods.
- Bookings of 10 or more during summer: Guests at AAC rates.
- 5 day discount rate Sunday - Friday only.

## MAKING A BOOKING

### For bookings to be accepted

- Current annual subscription must have been paid
- Payment in full must accompany bookings

### Priorities

- Different priority bookings are processed on the different dates. When lodging bookings that have different priorities, it is essential to send separate booking forms and separate cheques for the different priorities, otherwise your bookings will be processed at the date of the lowest priority you lodge.

### Family and guests

- Non-member spouse and children of a member must be accompanied by the member.
- The lodges are run for their members. Guests must be booked, and paid for, by their accompanying member.

### Information to be supplied when making a booking

- For each applicant being booked please supply full name, sex and membership status (ie 1st, 2nd, 3rd or 4th priority)
- The dates you require and any second preference dates.
- Telephone numbers & email addresses where you can be contacted day and night. Mail & fax bookings must be on printed booking form.

### What to take

- Bookings voucher must be taken to all lodges.
- Linen to all lodges, except where shown in next column.

### Changing bookings

Bookings are made available only to the people specifically named on booking vouchers. Bookings are not transferable. If someone booked can't attend, a new booking must be made through the booking agent, who will give preference to those on the waiting list. Please don't arrive at the lodge with a 'transferred' booking - it won't be accepted.

### Cancelling bookings

- Please notify cancellations promptly
- Applications for refunds must be made in writing to the relevant lodge committee, by the end of the season. Enclose booking agent's cancellation voucher and original booking voucher.

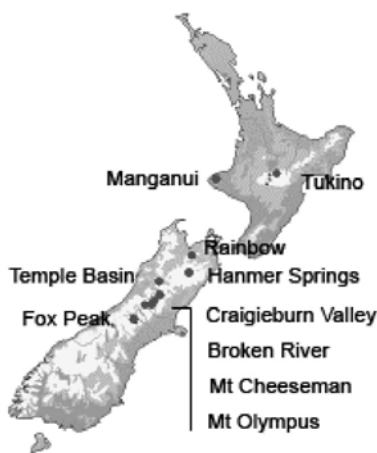
